#### **POLICE REPORT:**

- Chief Fitzgerald stated a draft MOU has been created for the SRO agreement and we are awaiting revisions from the School District.
- There has been an uptick in domestic/misdemeanor arrests over the last several months
  at specific rental properties. Since August there have been seven arrests involving
  residents of Maroa Capital, LLC properties or residents of Country Place Apartments.
  Contact information to property management for both organizations is lacking. Chief
  Fitzgerald would like Council input on drafting an ordinance which would require rental
  property owners to maintain current contact information with the City.
- Tony Caccomo had a fine installment due on 11/25/2024 but failed to make the
  payment. Chief Fitzgerald attempted to contact Mr. Caccomo on 11/26/2024 and
  12/2/2024. Both attempts yielded no results. Chief Fitzgerald will send Mr. Caccomo a
  final warning before we forward the matter to collections.

#### **ATTORNEY REPORT:**

- Attorney Wise stated there is a date set for in January for Omar Sosa regarding 310 N
  Pine Street. It could be dismissed soon since he appears to have addressed most of the
  issues in question. She will try to push to keep it continued though to keep pressure on
  him to keep Omar doing what needs to be done.
- Solar Farm- Lindsey stated Alderperson West wanted the record to reflect that the City could not have prevented the solar project behind Casey's. It is within the jurisdiction of Macon County.

#### **ENGINEER REPORT:**

#### **ADMINISTRATOR/ZONING REPORT:**

- 400 block of Wood Street sidewalk Repair: This project is mostly completed. ADA
  mats have been installed at the McKinley Street and Jefferson Street intersections. We
  are looking for mats suitable to install on the asphalt walking/bike path. There will be
  some backfilling and seeding to perform in early spring.
- Maroa Lumber Co Apron: This project is completed.
- Paving addition outside of Scope: There was as addition area along Chestnut Street which was added to the paving work to prevent water penetration under the new and existing pavement. This required 40 tons of material at a separate cost of \$4,000.00. This maintenance cost is also TIF eligible.

 Building Codes: The updated building codes adopted in Ordinance 2024/09/09-1 have been submitted to the Illinois Capital Development Board and will become effective on January 1, 2025.

#### **PUBLIC WORKS REPORT:**

- Superintendent of Public Works Mike Hoffman informed the Council that leaf pick-up is on hold due to truck repairs. It will resume once the truck is repaired and returned.
- Mayor Wilkey stated in the last few months there has been a lot accomplished.
