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POLICE REPORT:

- One of the recently purchased used vehicles is up and running; The second is waiting on a few pieces of equipment which are on order. After the equipment is installed, the ID wrap will be added before joining service.
- Federal Signal, and Setina are trying to work out an engineering issue with the transport cage in the back seat and the factory-installed seat. We may have to choose between going with another manufacturer, opting for a hard rear seat that spans the entire width, keeping the manufactured seat in place, or going with no cage at all.
- The entire department participated in firearms training in a night setting. This training included exiting vehicles, deploying patrol rifles and completing a live fire training regimen which included a simulated "offender" vehicle. The department utilized donated windshields and doors that Rick Wikoff from Dewitt Sportsman's Club was able to obtain for us. Officers also conducted several other low-and no-light drills.
- Several Officers took part in a large-scale DUI crash reenactment at the high school.
- Some of the time-consuming cases that the police department has been working on:
 - 1. 2016 cold case Officer Meredith and Chief will be going up to Statesville Prison in Joliet next week to interview the suspect.
 - 2. Another victim has come forward in the Fenton case.
 - 3. Macon County Sheriff collaborative case The State's Attorney will not only be charging the suspect, but she has upgraded/added a few new charges.
 - 4. There was traffic stop on September 5th, 2025 conducted by Officer Lawson and assisted by Chief Fitzgerald and the department intern immediately after the home football game at Washington and 51. It resulted in the arrest of an armed habitual felony who had on his person a stolen, loaded 9 mm hand gun and a loaded 34-round magazine.
- Olivia Lily had some concerns for Chief Fitzgerald and Chief Fitzgerald told her he would look into them and get back to her on those concerns.

ATTORNEY REPORT:

- Attorney Wise stated that the Foreclosure sale for the property located at 418 South Wood Street is on October 15th, 2025, at 8:30 a.m.
- Attorney Wise has been discussing an Ordinance with Chief Fitzgerald and Administrator Agee on towing/impoundment policy.

ENGINEER REPORT:

 We have been approved for a \$275,000.00 grant from IDOT to cover the cost of preliminary engineering for updates to Wood Street. Proposed updates include replacing sidewalks, ADA compliant approaches, reconfiguring traffic lanes and adding bike lanes.

ADMINISTRATOR/ZONING REPORT:

• We closed on the purchase of the former railroad property from Deer Meadow Farms on September 23rd. The total purchase amount, after fees, was \$17,316.91.

PUBLIC WORKS REPORT:

- Two water filters have had media replaced and work on the remaining two is planned for next week.
- Hydrant flushing is scheduled to start around October 13th and will last for approximately three weeks.
- The six-foot partition fence has been installed in the pickleball courts.
