Job Summary

The City of Maroa is seeking a strategic, transparent, and experienced leader to serve as Chief of Police. The Chief will provide executive leadership, command the police department's operations, and foster a culture of integrity and community-oriented policing. The successful candidate will manage all personnel and law enforcement operations ensuring public safety through proactive community engagement. The Chief will also assist in the development and maintenance of the annual police department budget as authorized by the City Council.

Key Responsibilities

- **Strategic Leadership:** Develop and implement department strategies, goals, and policies in compliance with local, state, and federal laws.
- **Community Policing:** Build and maintain trust with the community through open communication and active engagement.
- **Operational Command:** Oversee daily operations, patrol, investigations, SRO program and emergency responses.
- **Personnel Management:** Manage, train, mentor, and evaluate staff, fostering a professional, diverse, and equitable environment.
- **Budgeting & Fiscal Management:** Develop and maintain the department's budget under advisement of the City Administrator, manage grants, and optimize resources.
- **Collaboration:** Work with the school district, community leaders, elected officials, and other law enforcement and public service agencies.

Qualifications

- **Experience:** Preferred 8–15 years of law enforcement experience, with at least 3–5 years in a supervisory or command position.
- **Education:** Preferred bachelor's degree in criminal justice, public administration, or a related field.
- **Certification:** Current certification as a law enforcement officer (or eligibility to obtain one) in the state of Illinois.
- **Training:** Specialized leadership or organizational training preferred.
