The gym is \$50.00 to rent and \$120.00 deposit.






## **PSN/SHUT OFF**

In most cases, City permits are required to ensure compliance with building codes, property line setbacks, zoning regulations, and other state and local requirements. Please consider the following information BEFORE beginning any projects:

- Some common projects requiring permits include asphalt or concrete work, structure alterations and additions, new or replacement fencing, swimming pools, solar panels porches, patios and decks, roof repairs or replacement, storage sheds, construction of any new structure, and demolition of any existing structure. Always verify if your project requires a permit prior to beginning any work by contacting City Hall.
- Illinois law requires anyone contracting for roof repair or replacement work to be licensed by the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation. City permit petitions require contractors to provide necessary licensing information to help protect businesses, homeowners, and neighbors.
- Some projects may require a variance or special use permit to be compliant with the City
  Code. After a public hearing with the Planning and Zoning Board, a recommendation is
  submitted to the Maroa City Council for consideration and authorization by ordinance. If
  the variance or special use is approved, permits can be issued. Due to state regulations
  regarding publication of notice, this process generally takes 30 to 60 days to complete.
- Many projects require property line markers to be located and exposed for setback verification. If property line markers cannot be located, you must have the parcel surveyed prior to receiving a permit.
- Fillable PDF petitions for permits are available at maroaillinois.gov and paper copies are
  available at City Hall. The petition for a permit must be completed in entirety (including
  all requested information) and submitted to City Hall for verification and approval. A
  certificate will only be issued after the petition is approved and associated fees are paid.
  Work on the project can only begin once a certificate is issued and posted.
- You are required by state law to contact J.U.L.I.E (dial 811) for locating services before
  proceeding with any excavation. This includes hand digging at any depth. The
  individual performing the digging MUST be the one to submit a J.U.L.I.E ticket.
- Failure to obtain a building permit prior to work being performed will result in doubled fees, processing delays, and possible fines.

We here at the police department hope everyone is enjoying the (very hot) summer with friends and family! While we have lots of kids running around enjoying themselves, we ask that everyone keep an eye out when those youngsters are out and about on foot, bikes, scooters and made even roller-skates???

When we all received our permit for our golf carts, part of that process was signing that we all would follow all rules of the road and ordinances. This does include stop signs, using turn signals and such. We have seen an increase in young folks not being secured in seatbelts while in the carts and this does pose a major safety concern. For those that have seatbelts in their carts, I implore you to please secure those kidos! Now, there are some carts that do not have seat belts installed, so this presents a challenge. However, we may have a solution to that challenge.

Community Service Officer Chris Ware recently attended the Child Passenger Safety Technician Conference and learned about a newer child safety product. It is a removable child safety seat/harness that is specifically designed for golf carts. It is for both those that do and do not have seatbelts installed. I found the product on Amazon under two names "Lil' Caddie Child Positioner" and "Urgrown Golf Cart Child

Positioner". CSO Ware has Lil Caddie brand coupons for 25% off and free shipping that he would love to share with our residents. Please reach out to the department so we can get those into your hands, while supplies last.

Another solution that is available for those without manufactured seatbelts installed is purchasing a kit to install them yourself. Several companies sell these, and they appear relatively not to difficult to install.

Now, to keep our general council happy, we are not endorsing, affiliated, nor receiving any compensation for sales of these products! Every parent should weigh their own child's safety for themselves. I just wanted to bring possible solutions to
