School is now back in session and the safety of our students is paramount. The Maroa Police Department is asking that all drivers remain aware of their speed, and students walking to and from school. The speed limit in any school zone is 20 MPH. As a reminder the Illinois law requires that when a school bus is stopped vehicles traveling in both directions on any highway, roadway, private road, parking lot, school property or any other location, must come to a complete stop. This is to ensure the safe loading and unloading of the students and their crossing of roadways. Please be vigilant while driving near any school and report any violations immediately.











§ 195-1Burning garbage and wastes.

<u>A.</u>

The open burning of commercial, agricultural and domicile waste within the City limits of the City of Maroa is prohibited. "Domicile waste" is defined as any refuse generated on residential property as a result of domiciliary activities.



B.

It shall be unlawful to burn any landscape waste within the City limits except between sunrise and sunset on Monday through Saturday, and from 12:00 noon on Sunday to sunset, and only upon the premises where it is produced. "Landscape waste" means all accumulations of grass or shrubbery cuttings, leaves and other materials accumulating as a result of the care of lawns, shrubbery, vines and trees.

§ 195-2**Permissible burning.**

Notwithstanding the provisions of this chapter, it shall not be prohibited to openly burn landscape waste from sunset to sunrise on each day of the week, provided that the burning of such landscape waste is performed solely for recreational purposes and not for waste disposal purposes. Any such recreational burning of landscape waste will only be permitted where such activity is supervised by a person 18 years of age or older.



LEAF PICK-UP

Leaf pick-up will begin mid-October through the first week of December. LEAVES ONLY. NO OTH-ER YARD WASTE PER-MITTED. Please make sure if you want the leaves picked up that you get them as close to the road as possible so, the guys can dispose of them. If you decide to burn the leaves then the burning times are sunrise to sunset on Monday through Saturday, and from 12:00 (noon) on Sunday to sunset. Thank you for your cooperation.


