An ordinance amending the City of Maroa Code of Ordinances,
Specifically, 218-32 waste collection receptacles was passed on
September 8, 2025.

this could be put in our next newsletter, so this is why it is being
posted now in the newsletter.

The ordinance states

“218-32 Waste Collection receptacles

It shall be unlawful to store or leave standing waste collection
receptacles within the City right-of-way more than 24 hours before
and 24 hours after disposal pick up.”

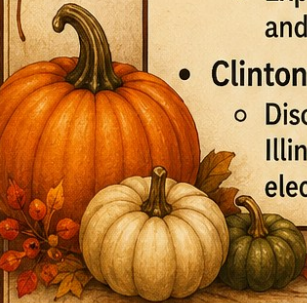
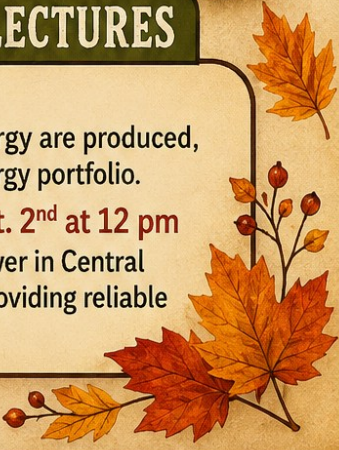

§ 195-1 BURNING GARBAGE AND WASTES

§ 195-1

- A.** The open burning of commercial, agricultural and domicile waste within the City limits of the City of Maroa is prohibited. "Domicile waste" is defined as any refuse generated on residential property as a result of domiciliary activities.



- B.** It shall be unlawful to burn any landscape waste within the City limits except between sunrise and sunset on Monday through Saturday, and from 12:00 noon on Sunday to sunset, and only upon the premises where it is produced. "Landscape waste" means all accumulations of grass or shrubbery cuttings, leaves and other materials accumulating as a result of the care of lawns, shrubbery, vines and trees.

§ 195-2 PERMISSIBLE BURNING



Notwithstanding the provisions of this chapter, it shall not be prohibited to openly burn landscape waste from sunset to sunrise on each day of the week, provided that the burning of such landscape waste is performed solely for recreational purposes and not for waste disposal purposes. Any such recreational burning of landscape waste will only be permitted where such activity is supervised by a person 18 years of age or older.





FALL LEAF PICKUP



CURB SIDE LEAF COLLECTION POLICY

OBJECTIVE:

TO PROVIDE CITY RESIDENTS AND BUSINESS OWNERS WITH AN ECONOMICAL WAY OF DISPOSING LEAVES WITHOUT BURNING.

GOAL:

COLLECT ALL LEAVES THAT ARE PLACED IN CITY OWNED RIGHT-OF-WAY EACH WEEKDAY OR THE FOLLOWING DAY AFTER A HOLIDAY OR WEEKEND.

RULES:

- 1 LEAF PILES ARE TO BE PLACED SO THAT VACUUM EQUIPMENT CAN BE USED. PLACING LEAVES AROUND MAIL BOXES, SIGN OR UTILITY POLES AND INTERSECTIONS CAUSES DELAYS IN THE COLLECTION PROCESS, SO IF THEY ARE PLACED ANY WHERE NEAR THOSE THEY WILL NOT BE PICKED UP.
- 2 LANDSCAPE WASTE SUCH AS GRASS CLIPPINGS, GARDEN WASTE ARE PROHIBITED DUE TO THE POTENTIAL OF CHEMICAL RESIDUES, THAT MAY INTERFERE WITH CROP GROWTH ON LAND IN WHICH THE LEAVES ARE APPLIED.
- 3 MIXED PILES OF LEAVES AND TREE LIMBS OR OTHER LANDSCAPE WASTE SHALL NOT BE COLLECTED.
- 4 BURNING OF LEAVES IS PERMITTED. THE CITY BURN ORDINANCE SHALL APPLY.
- 5 LEAVES MUST BE IN PLACE FOR COLLECTION BY 8AM OF THE COLLECTION DAY.
- 6 THE CITY STAFF HAS A RIGHT TO REFUSE TO REMOVE ANY LANDSCAPE WASTE DEEMED NOT IN COMPLIANCE WITH OUR GUIDELINES.
- 7 IT IS NOT THE CITY STAFFS RESPONSIBILITY TO ASSIST CITY RESIDENTS IN REMOVING LANDSCAPE WASTE THAT DOES NOT QUALIFY AS LEAVES.

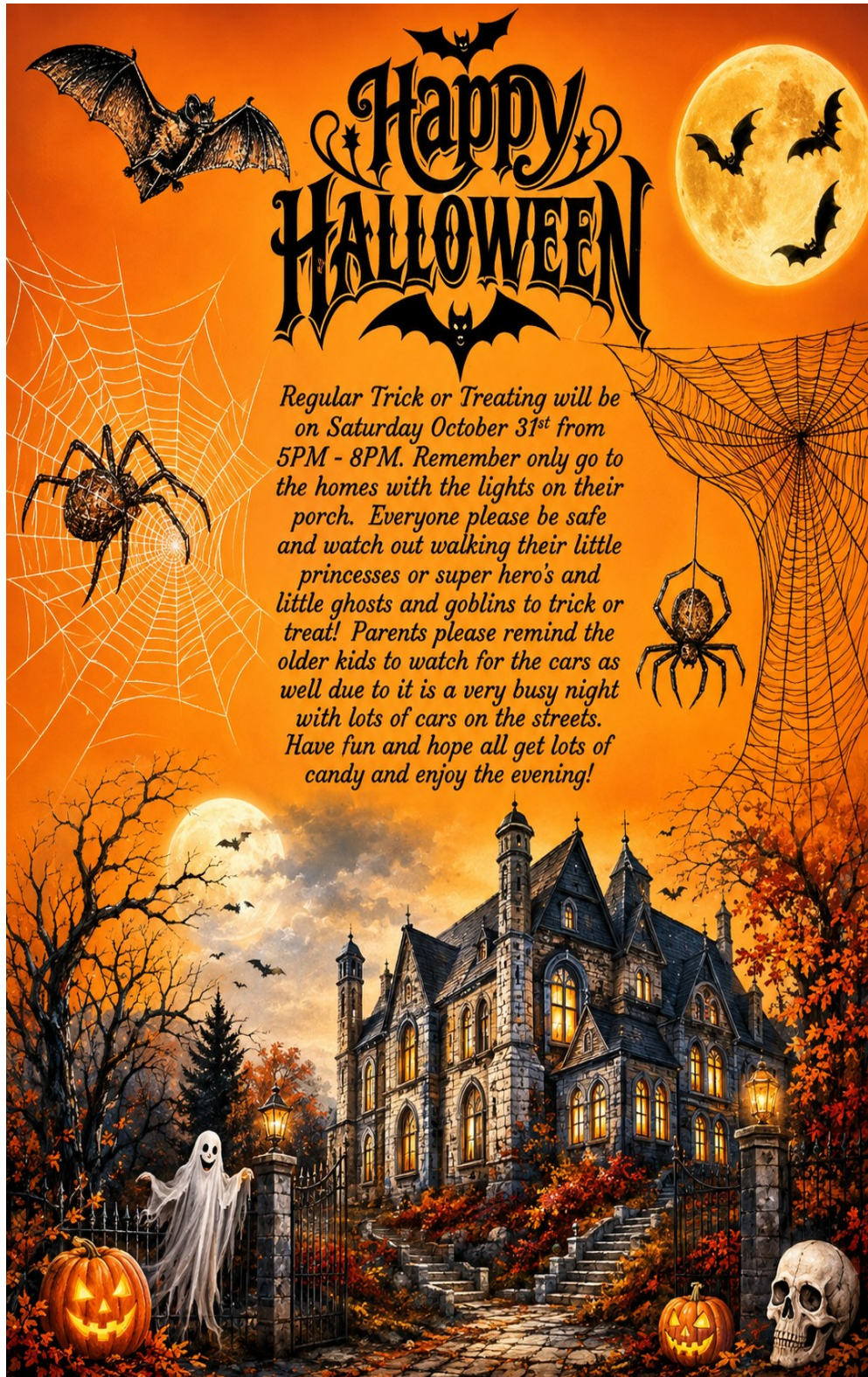

WATER SHUT OFF/ PSN

To avoid water shut off's please pay any balance that is due by the shut off dates.
Here are the remainder dates for this year.

September 22, 2026 @ 9:30 a.m.

November 24, 2026 @ 9:30 a.m.

Also remember bills are always due on the 17th of each month by 3 p.m. If they are paid after the 17th after 3 p.m. they will get a 15% late fee attached to them.

If you do not receive your bill or your bill by email by the end of each month, please give us a call and we will be happy to tell you the amount or get you another copy.

We are always here to help so please do not hesitate to give us a call.

We know no one likes to get their water shut off and we do not like to have to shut people's water off so that is why we are sending out another reminder that you might put on you frig or your calendar to help avoid getting your water shut off anytime this year. Also please remember if you do happen to get shut off please do not go on PSN and pay. Please call City Hall and get your balance first because PSN will not have the correct amount yet for you to get turned back on and PSN does not notify us when a payment is made. So we will not know right away to to turn you back on. So it is important for you to call in to City Hall or come in to pay your bill when you get shut off to get turned back on. We just want to make sure that we can get you back on as soon as possible once you have paid. There is usually someone that stay s late on shutoff night as well. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter. Also please do not put cash in the box or medicine in the drop box either!

Building Permits & Related Information

In most cases, City permits are required to ensure compliance with building codes, property line setbacks, zoning regulations, and other state and local requirements. Please consider the following information **BEFORE** beginning any projects:

- Some common projects requiring permits include asphalt or concrete work, structure alterations and additions, new or replacement fencing, swimming pools, solar panels porches, patios and decks, roof repairs or replacement, storage sheds, construction of any new structure, and demolition of any existing structure. Always verify if your project requires a permit prior to beginning any work by contacting City Hall.
- Illinois law requires anyone contracting for roof repair or replacement work to be licensed by the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation. City permit petitions require contractors to provide necessary licensing information to help protect businesses, homeowners, and neighbors.
- Some projects may require a variance or special use permit to be compliant with the City Code. After a public hearing with the Planning and Zoning Board, a recommendation is submitted to the Maroa City Council for consideration and authorization by ordinance. If the variance or special use is approved, permits can be issued. Due to state regulations regarding publication of notice, this process generally takes 30 to 60 days to complete.
- Many projects require property line markers to be located and exposed for setback verification. If property line markers cannot be located, you must have the parcel surveyed prior to receiving a permit.
- Fillable PDF petitions for permits are available at maroailinois.gov and paper copies are available at City Hall. The petition for a permit must be completed in entirety (including all requested information) and submitted to City Hall for verification and approval. A certificate will only be issued after the petition is approved and associated fees are paid. Work on the project can only begin once a certificate is issued and posted.
- You are required by state law to contact J.U.L.I.E (dial 811) for locating services before proceeding with any excavation. This includes hand digging at any depth. The individual performing the digging **MUST** be the one to submit a J.U.L.I.E ticket.

Failure to obtain a building permit prior to work being performed will result in doubled fees, processing delays, and possible fines.

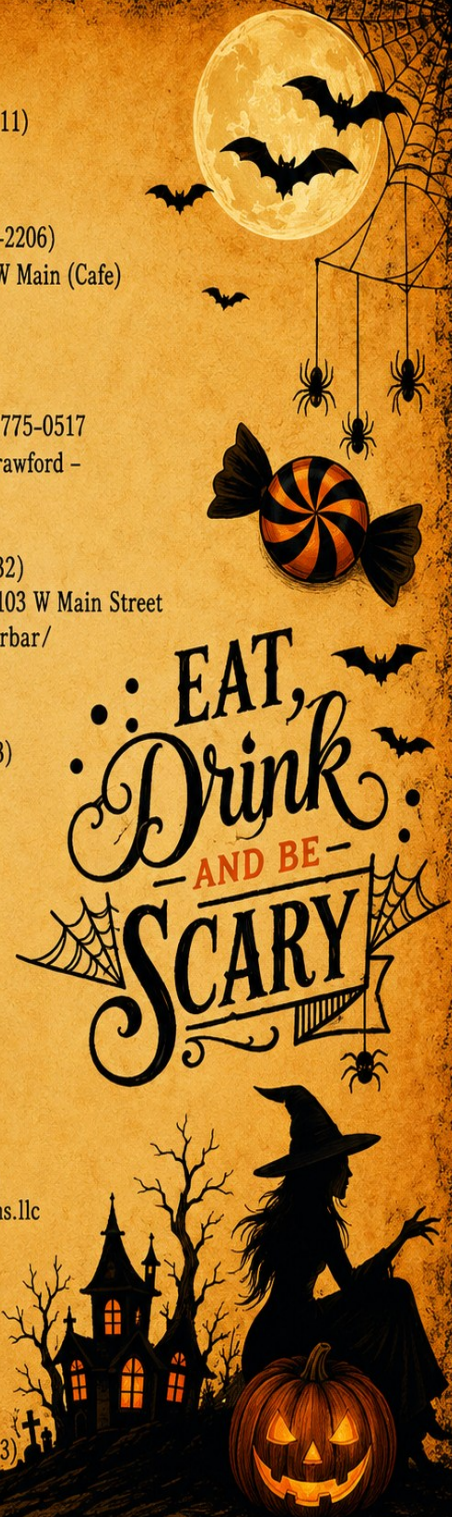
