Police Officer – Part-Time

Duties:

All Police functions pertaining to traffic, criminal, and city ordinance's. Handle all other Police functions as assigned by City Board or Police Chief.

Minimum Qualifications include:

21 years of age
U.S. Citizen
High School Graduate (or Equivalent)
Valid Driver's License (minimal driving record)
Valid FOID Card
Good Moral Character
Good Mental and Physical Condition
No Felony or Domestic Violence Convictions

MUST BE a graduate of one of either the full-time or part-time sworn police officer training programs and be State of Illinois Certified, or have appropriate training and certification from another state that is compatible with the Illinois Law Enforcement Training And Standards Board.

All qualified applications will be required to:

Pass an Oral Interview,
Pass a thorough Background Investigation,
Pass a Pre-employment Physical, and Drug Screening

Applications can be picked up at City Hall / Police Department (120 S. Locust Street, Maroa Illinois) or visit City Of Maroa Webpage (maroaininois.gov) to Download. The Application should have all Certifications attached when submitting.

There is no guarantee of employment at any point in this process until the applicante has met all the necessary approvals and qualifications set by City Officials.

If you are not currently certified and/or a sworn police officer, please do not apply.
