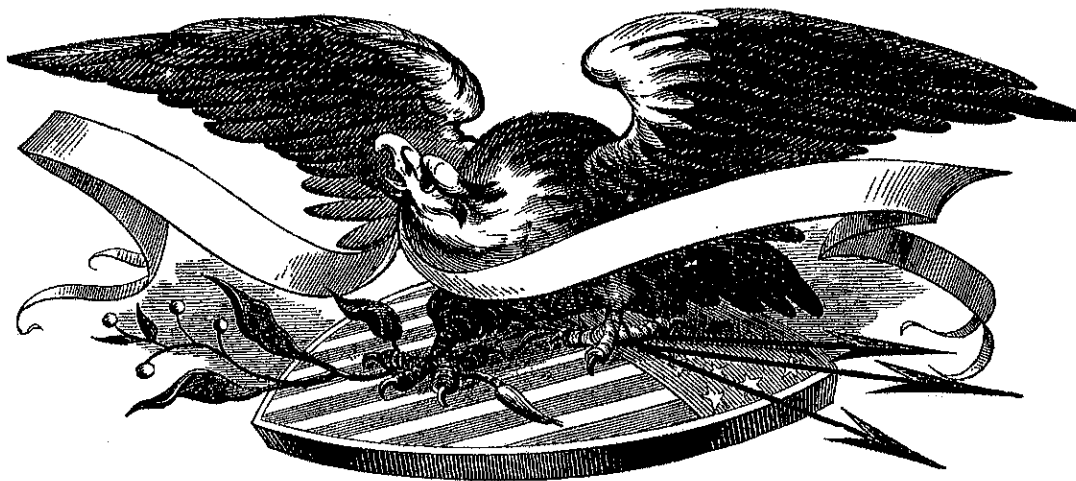

SECTION 4: That the total amount of Two Hundred Sixty Eight Thousand Two Hundred Ninety Five Dollars and Sixty-Four Cents (**\$268,295.64**) ascertained as aforesaid be, and the same is hereby, levied and assessed on all property subject to taxation within the City of Maroa according to the value of said property as the same is assessed and equalized for State and County purposes for the current year.

SECTION 5: That the City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the County Clerk of Macon County within the time specified by law.


SECTION 6: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.




CERTIFICATION OF TAX LEVY ORDINANCE
