This reservation is made with the understanding that the following regulations must be adhered to, as must all City Ordinances governing the park. Any violations may result in the group's eviction and denial of future requests.

1. We ask that your arrival time be as accurate as possible as reservations will be held for one hour past stated time. If the party does not arrive in that time, their reservations will be cancelled. As a courtesy to others, we ask that if you cannot keep your reservation you notify us as soon as possible.
2. Individuals must be 18 or older to reserve the pavilion.
3. All vehicles must remain in the designated parking area.
4. All litter and refuse from your outing must be deposited in the provided containers. The area in which your outing takes place must be kept in a clean and orderly condition.
5. Alcoholic beverages are allowed for persons 21 years of age or older, with positive identification and a permit from the Mayor. Excessive drinking will not be tolerated. Beer kegs are prohibited.
6. Grills are provided for fires. Fires are not allowed in any other area.
7. Please observe posted park hours.
8. The playground equipment, horseshoe pits, volleyball courts, parking lots, and other such facilities are not included in your reservation and will be open to the public on a first-come, first-serve basis.
