Main Street Wi-Fi: The Wi-Fi system is up and running. We did have some repairs made to the electrical supply on the light poles and anticipate some updates soon to the outlet boxes which supply the Wi-Fi and power for the Christmas lights.

Sidewalk Project: The sidewalk installation along Locust Street is complete, save for some backfilling and seeding. The crew has moved to the Main Street portion of the project.

Crawford's Façade Grant: Matt Crawford has submitted his application for a matching sign grant. All paperwork is in order and complete. The total project cost is \$5,040.03 which brings the allowed matching grant funds to a total of \$2,500.00, submitted to City Council for approval and release.

City Hall Internet: In addition to the improvements made to the City Hall ethernet system, I was able to secure a new router for the system from Frontier. This new router has more capacity than our old one and has increased performance for our internet needs.

Spencer Park: It is my understanding the playground equipment has been fully installed. There were two brackets missing from the hardware ordered last week, which have arrived today and will be installed by Mike by end of day tomorrow.

Crawford's Retention Pond: Mike and I have met with Matt Crawford regarding the completion of the site drainage plans. The retention pond and outlet structure will be completed as per the engineering plans.

Camera System: THFVS recommends two cameras to cover the courtyard area. The quote for the installation and programming of the system is \$1,127.00

RR Parcel Appraisal: As requested, I secured an appraisal on the southern section of former railroad right-of-way from Jack Wagner. His completed appraisal should arrive early this week.

Audit History: I received the audit history files from Kevin Buckley's office today. I'll start the process of stitching the years together so we can see a broader picture of how things have been progressing.
