Water Meter Reader: I have requested a quote from the vendor to return the hand-held Trimble unit for credit and replace it with a Sensus hand-held unit. I will advise when a quote is submitted.

Coastal Inspection: The appraisal is complete and I have provided Mayor Meador with a copy of the 44 page report. The fair market value of the property in its current condition is \$25,000, as compared to the inspection estimate of \$55,696.55 to bring the property into compliance.

Budget: I have been working with Michelle and the department heads on the budget and will be scheduling a meeting with the Finance Committee as soon as it is feasible for them to meet. I have also been restructuring the format to match the monthly Budget Comparison Report.

USDA Funding: Mike Hoffman and I will be scheduling a meeting with the USDA representative to discuss funding programs available and their applicability towards infrastructure improvements within the City.

EPA Loan Program: According to guidelines, the City of Maroa appears to be eligible for loan principal forgiveness of up to 30% for sewer projects and 75% for water projects. Mike Hoffman and I will be assembling a plan for various projects in these categories to propose for submission to the EPA in the future.
